


Better Sleep Guide - 8 Tips for a Good Night's Sleep

"It's important to make an overall commitment to healthy, restorative sleep. There is a critical connection between a supportive, comfortable mattress, sleeping great and living well. Here are some tips from the Better Sleep Council for maintaining a healthy sleep environment to ensure the best night's rest possible."

1. Make sleep a priority by keeping a consistent bedtime and wake schedule, including weekends.
2. Create a bedtime routine that is relaxing. Experts recommend reading a book, listening to soothing music or soaking in a hot bath.
3. Create a room that is dark, quiet, comfortable and cool for the best possible sleep.
4. Evaluate your mattress and pillow to ensure proper comfort and support. If your mattress is five to seven years old, it may be time for a new one. In general, pillows should be replaced every year.
5. Keep work materials, computers and televisions out of the bedroom.
6. Exercise regularly, but complete workouts at least two hours before bedtime.
7. If you sleep with a partner, your mattress should allow each of you enough space to move easily. A queen mattress is ideal for two people sharing a mattress.
8. Avoid eating, alcohol, nicotine and caffeine close to bedtime. These can lead to poor sleep, keep you awake or disrupt sleep later in the night.

Limited Warranty

All Park Place sleep systems are backed by our 80 plus years in the mattress business. We desire to give you the best nights's sleep you've ever had. Part of our ongoing quality process is the promise that our products will be free from defects in materials and workmanship. In the event warranty service is required, take a few minutes to review these guidelines.

Length of Warranty

This warranty starts on the date of purchase. For length of warranty refer to the product's law tag and the warranty schedule. Repair or replacement of the mattress or foundation neither renews nor extends this limited warranty.

If a Problem Occurs

In the unlikely event a problem with this product occurs, contact the store where you bought it. If you cannot reach the store or if you have moved, contact us via email at warranty@parkplacecorp.com, or mail to Park Place Corporation, Attn Customer Care, PO Box 8127, Greenville, SC 29604.

For this limited warranty to be valid, 1) you must be the original purchaser and have purchased the sleep set from one of our authorized dealers in the U.S., 2) provide a copy of the original store receipt or other proof of date, place of purchase and purchase price and 3) the law label must be attached to the product.

If the problem occurs during the no-charge period based on information on the law tag and the warranty schedule, PPC will repair or replace at our discretion your mattress or foundation, but only the defective piece, delivered to the selling dealer within a reasonable period of time without charge to you.

If such a problem occurs after the no-charge period but prior to the end of the warranty period, PPC will repair or replace at PPC's discretion with a charge to you as determined from the warranty schedule.

Replacement or repair of your defective mattress or foundation is the only remedy under this warranty. If identical materials are not available at the time of product service, PPC reserves the right to substitute materials of equal or higher quality or at PPC's discretion provide a refund.

What This Warranty Does Not Cover

- Mattress fabric including stains, soiling or burns. Mattress covers are not colorfast. We recommend you use a mattress pad to protect the mattress surface.
- Permanent body contouring of 2" or less.
- Border wires, which run along the mattress and foundation perimeter, bent during moving or bending of the sleep set.
- Mattress damage due to use of an improper foundation. This mattress is designed for full performance when used in conjunction with a matching foundation as part of a total sleep system.
- Replacement of another, non-defective piece in the sleep set.
- Comfort preference.

- Structural damage from using an improper bed frame. This warranty applies to a king or queen size mattress or foundation ONLY if they are used on a bed frame with a center support having at least 5 legs or 5 hardwood cross slats.
- Clearance products sold "as is" and floor models.
- Bed height.
- Transportation costs.
- Park Place reserves the right to refuse service when the product is found to be soiled or in an unsanitary condition or when product failure is due to causes other than defective materials or workmanship.

Exclusive Remedy / Other Limitations

Any and all implied warranties on this product, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, shall not exceed in duration the term of this limited warranty which begins with the date of purchase by the consumer. The service terms stated in this warranty shall be the consumer's sole and exclusive remedy in the event of product failure during the warranty period. Park Place shall not be liable for incidental or consequential damages arising out of the use or inability to use this product or for the breach of this or any other express or implied warranty. Park Place does not warrant this product being suitable for any person's medical condition. Park Place makes no warranty beyond what is stated in writing.

Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so this limitation may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state. Park Place does not authorize any person to create for it any other obligation or liability in connection with this warranty.
